

Karaka (*Corynocarpus laevigatus*) of rohe of Rangitāne o Manawatū as a horticultural and food enterprise

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Project Description:

A multi-year and multi-party collaboration investigation weaving mātauranga Māori and pūtaiao (science) to investigate karaka (*Corynocarpus laevigatus*), within the rohe of Rangitāne o Manawatū, as a horticultural and food enterprise.

This has involved genomic investigations to determine genetic diversity, developing fruit and seed/nut processing protocols, food product concepts, resource optimisation (waste mitigation), and agronomy.

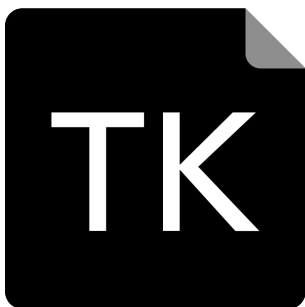


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
